## Shivalik Bimetal Controls Limited reports minor fire incident at main plant; no casualties and no damage to equipment

**New Delhi, India – January 29th, 2026:** Shivalik Bimetal Controls Limited (SBCL) confirmed a minor fire incident at its main manufacturing facility in the packaging area between 10:15 and 10:25 PM on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2026. In-house fire-fighting and local fire authorities responded promptly, and the fire has been fully extinguished. There were no casualties, and no damage to machinery or production equipment. The incident caused minimal damage limited to the packing area.

### Management Commentary:

***Mr. Kabir Ghumman, Managing Director, said:***

“Safety is our top priority at Shivalik, and in any such incident our first concern is always the well-being of our people. The fire was limited to the packaging area and was controlled quickly by our in-house fire-fighting team, with timely support from the local fire authorities. The cause of the fire is under investigation. I sincerely thank our colleagues on site for their prompt response, and the fire teams for their help.

The impact was limited, with minimal damage confined to the packing area. Importantly, there were no injuries and no damage to any production equipment. Operations and customer deliveries remain on track. We have adequate insurance coverage for such incidents, and have initiated an internal review to strengthen preventive measures and ensure safe, stable operations.”
